## DOWN

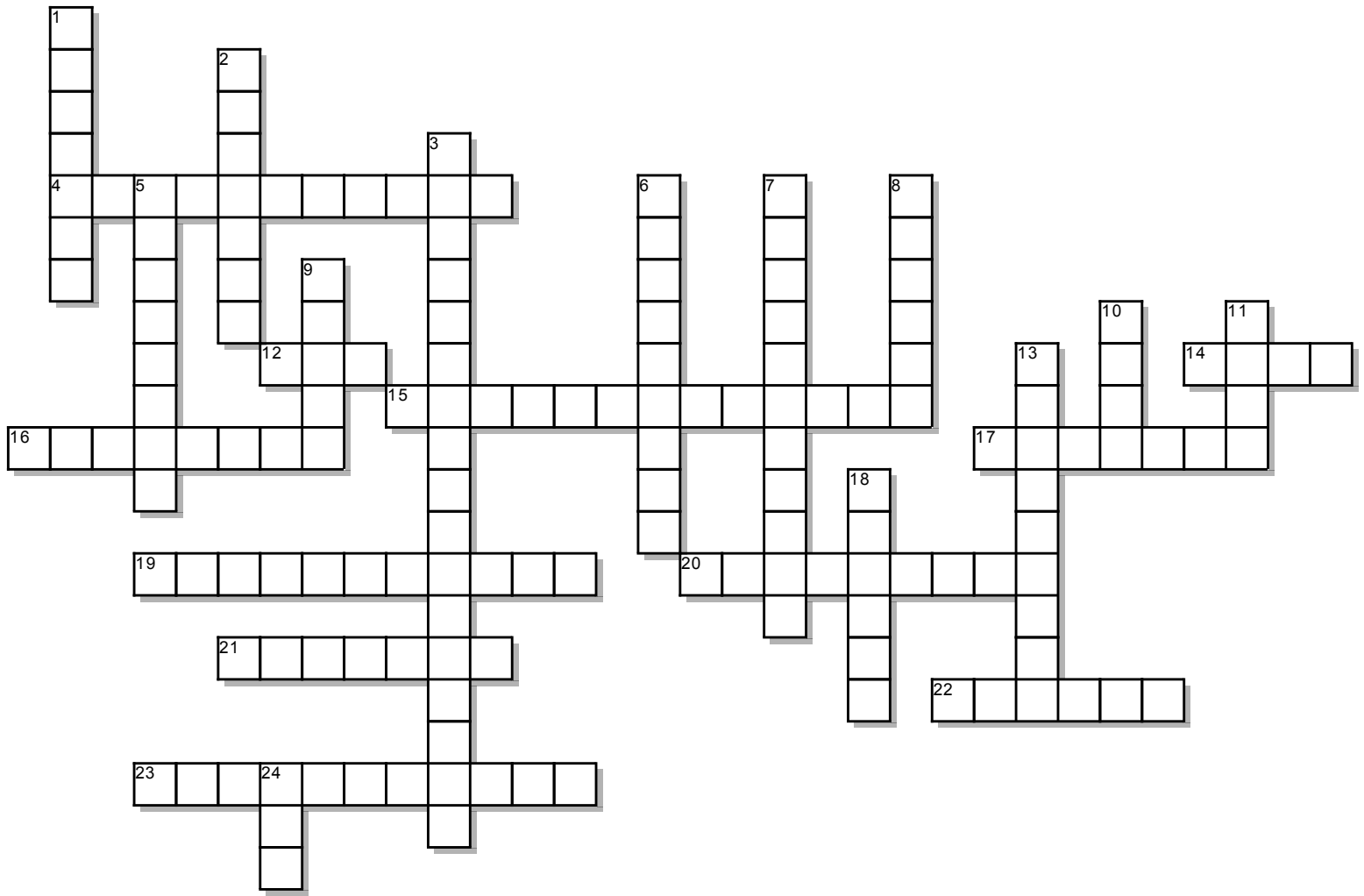
- 1 Butterfly that looks much like a Monarch butterfly
- 2 Not evolved
- 3 White, usually have dark spot or two. The green caterpillar in the garden eats your cabbages, broccoli, etc.
- 5 Not by chance
- 6 Wings brightly colored, usually held straight up, flies by day
- 7 The scientific name for butterflies, moths and skippers
- 8 What covers the wings of butterflies and moths.
- 9 What butterflies use to fly
- 10 The insect inside the chrysalis
- 11 Most have dull-colored wings/ hold their wings flat, and fly by night
- 13 The "drinking straw" or "tongue" of a moth or butterfly
- 18 Has 3 body parts, 6 legs, no inner skeleton
- 24 Comes before the caterpillar
