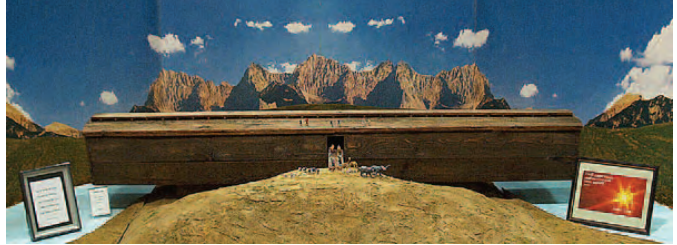
Science Programs
